ACADEMICS:

We, at CKPS, continuously strive to keep our academic standards high. Reports are handed out after each term, thus ensuring that parents are kept fully up to date with the progress of their children for each term. Our TOP TEN system is still in place, and learners are given their badges in the second week of the term in recognition of this.
