The EXAMINATIONS for Grades 4 – 7 will commence on 13 November and the final Exam will be written on 21 November.

Please note that the results for this Exam will impact on the End of Year marks and it is therefore very important that the learners study for each and every paper. PLEASE BE AWARE THAT EXAMINATIONS MISSED WILL REQUIRE A DOCTOR'S NOTE!!

I would like to bring the following under your attention, in order for you to help your child prepare for the Exams and to know what to expect:

- The learners will be writing in their register classes.
- If no exams are being written in any of the sessions, the learners should be studying.
- Please ensure that your child is on time every day.
- Learners need to have suitcases/dividers up between them on the desks.
- They will not be allowed to press on any book while writing an Exam.
- **Stationery must be in a clear, see-through zip lock back or pencil bag.**
- Please ensure that your child has the necessary stationery (including spares) before starting the exam.
- No reading of books or magazines will be allowed once the exam is finished. This will only be allowed during study sessions.
- **The Textbooks for each subject must be handed in on the day of the Exam. Lost Textbooks must be replaced or paid for. The cost per Textbook is R150.**
