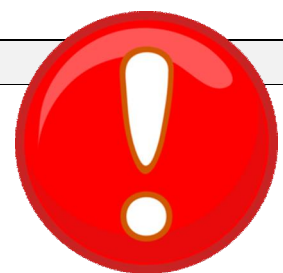

Kindly ensure that the office is aware of any changes in contact details. If a child is ill or injured we need to get hold of you **urgently**, and we rely on the information that you have supplied.

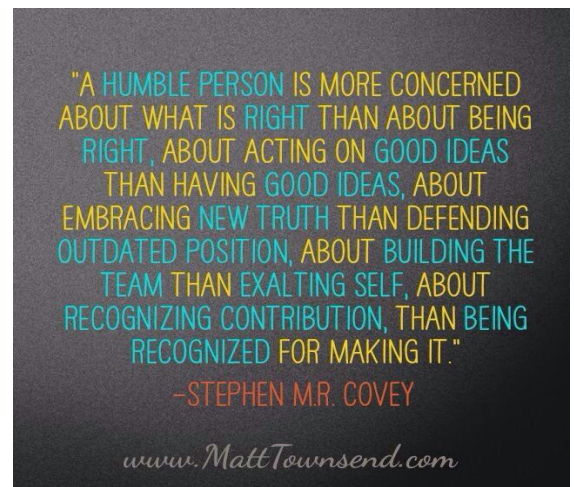


SGB BY-ELECTIONS
