As I am sure you are aware, EXAMINATIONS for Grades 4 – 7 will commence on 4 June and the final Exam will be written on 13 June.

Please note that the results for this Exam will have an impact on the End of Year marks and it is therefore very important that the learners study for each and every paper. PLEASE BE AWARE THAT EXAMINATIONS MISSED WILL REQUIRE A DOCTOR'S NOTE FOR THE DAY OF THE EXAMINATION AND THE DOCTOR MUST VERIFY THAT YOUR CHILD WAS TOO ILL TO WRITE THE SCHEDULED EXAMINATION ON THAT DAY!!

I would like to bring the following under your attention, in order for you to help your child prepare for the Examinations and to know what to expect:

- The learners will be writing in their register classes.
- If no examination is being written in any of the sessions, the learners should be studying.
- Please ensure that your child is on time every day, as being late for an Examination could lead to unnecessary stress.
- They will not be allowed to press on any book while writing an Examination.
- **Stationery must be in a clear, see-through zip lock back or clear pencil bag.**
- Please ensure that your child has the necessary stationery (including spares).
- No reading of books or magazines will be allowed once the examination is finished. This will only be allowed during study sessions.
- Given the potential security risks, no Smart Watches are permitted.
