It serves to be noted that work missed out as a result of such absenteeism is impossible to catch up and places the learner and the educators under unnecessary strain.

Dear Parents,

Please see below the content for the talk on 18 June. I would encourage you to come along with your child to hear more about how to manage **STRESS** as well, especially our **Grade 7 learners** who are facing new challenges in High School.

### **Anger Management Talk Content**

1. What is anger?
  - a. Definition: An emotion not a behaviour
  - b. Explosive and or a passive experience
  - c. Fire Cracker diagram to explain fight or flight response to anger
2. What causes anger?
  - a. Triggers or reasons for anger
    - i. Parents behaviour – Poor example of anger management
    - ii. Parents' divorce or separation
    - iii. Absent parents
    - iv. Peer victimisation
      1. Being shamed
      2. Peer exclusion
      3. Constant teasing
    - v. Constant arguing with siblings, educators, parents...etc
    - vi. Not being listened to
    - vii. Academic issues and pressure to perform beyond their abilities
    - viii. Impulsive, no self-control
    - ix. ADD or other challenges
    - x. Friendship Conflicts
    - xi. Poor self-image / esteem
3. How do we express anger and the consequences?
  - a. Unhealthy ways to express anger
    - i. Over reaction
    - ii. Lash out physically
    - iii. Use words to inflict emotional revenge
    - iv. Become a bully
    - v. Deny it exists
  - b. Healthy ways to express anger
    - i. Express your feelings
    - ii. Be assertive
    - iii. Don't respond immediately, think before you speak
    - iv. Deal with the problem don't ignore it
    - v. Walk away
    - vi. Impulse control

4. How do I deal with anger and conflict?
  - i. Thomas-Kilmann – Conflict management styles
    1. Compete – I win at all costs and you lose – I will get my way
    2. Avoid – I lose, and you lose - nothing is dealt with, I deliberately ignore it
    3. Accommodate – I lose, you win – Put aside my needs to please others
    4. Compromise – I win some, you win some – This involves a willingness to sacrifice and maintain a relationship
    5. Collaborate – I win, you win – Discussion to find the cause, concerns and uncover mis-understanding
5. How to manage my anger?
  - a. Identify what things are currently making you angry (see number2)
    - i. How can I deal with these?
  - b. RID method
    - i. Recognise the feel and accept it
    - ii. Identify a different way to think about the problem
    - iii. Do something to calm down or solve problems
  - c. See the other side
    - i. Ask why the person is angry
    - ii. Empathy and compassion
    - iii. Care for another human being
    - iv. Respect for others
6. The consequences of anger have long-term effects
