WHAT IS "LOYALTY"?

Loyalty in Behaviour

As it applies to personal conduct, loyalty can be described as: **"Faithfully obeying my authorities and committing to significant relationships."**

Loyalty in Concept

In medieval Europe loyalty referred to mutual obligations between a landlord and the people who lived on his land. The lord provided protection and allowed social privileges for the people if they faithfully fulfilled their legal obligations to the lord. Loyalty was their legal duty.

As governments grew, the word loyalty meant allegiance to various ethnic, political, or religious organizations in society, or to the individual leaders of these entities.

Today, loyalty may be used to describe any constant allegiance. This commitment may be to another person, an organization, an idea, a country, a government, or a lifestyle. In some settings, loyalty is a duty; in others, it is a choice. It ranges in intensity from moderate supportiveness to affectionate devotion.
